



STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

Thank you for submitting an inquiry to the Revitalizing Auto Communities Environmental Response (“RACER”) Trust, the entity charged with remediating and redeveloping 89 Properties left behind in the GM Bankruptcy. The Trust appreciates your interest in working to restore and rehabilitate these sites, turning them into useful and productive properties.

In order to fairly evaluate the capabilities of your business, please submit a statement of qualifications (“SOQ”). Please include the following information in your statement, keeping in mind this list is intended to cover a wide variety of environmental consultants, so not all information may pertain to your specific area of expertise:

- Please provide a Company Profile.
- Summarize your most recent experience obtaining approvals of and implementing creative remedial plans in those states in which you are interested in performing services – provide names of key agency personnel and projects.
- Explain your firm’s ownership structure – (i.e. which owners are in which State or out of State, etc.) Please provide an organizational chart for ownership and technical staff applicable to the work you are interested in.
- Summarize your most recent experience with the applicable regional office of US EPA – provide names of key agency personnel and projects.
- What is your current work load in the States in which you propose to perform services and what is your need or ability to employ local workers; this should include numbers and types of employees in any field offices.
- Describe what you consider the biggest challenges to implementing a deed restricted remedy/closure and have you ever completed a RCRA Corrective Action closure with or without restriction – if so, when, where, and for whom?
- Describe the willingness of your company to partner with other firms, whether partnerships have happened in the past and/or currently exist.
- Describe any experience you have had in Brownfield redevelopment.
- Identify and provide resumes for Key Personnel who would be assigned to perform service in specific states and discuss staffing to ensure key staff will be available to pay priority attention to assigned projects.
- Identify any staff that are licensed or registered with a particular state remediation program.
- Please provide a list of client and regulatory agency personnel references that can attest to the work your company has completed.
- Have you performed any work within the past ten (10) years for GM or Motors Liquidation Company? Please describe.
- Describe any experience you have had with green remediation.
- Please describe your health and safety rating.

- Describe your quality assurance plan (how your company manages project implementation and deliverables quality).
- Please provide a description of your insurance limits.
- Describe your E&O claims history for the past five (5) years.
- Any additional information you feel is important for consideration.
- Please provide contact information for any follow up.

In reviewing the SOQ, the Trust will give higher priority to businesses within close proximity to the various sites, as well as businesses that meet the federal government guidelines for a women-owned small business (WOSB), a disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE), or a service-disabled veteran-owned small business (SDVOSB). The Trust also values the hiring of local individuals to work on site-rehabilitation and will take the proposed pool of workers into consideration.

The Trust will endeavor to review all SOQ responses when received.
